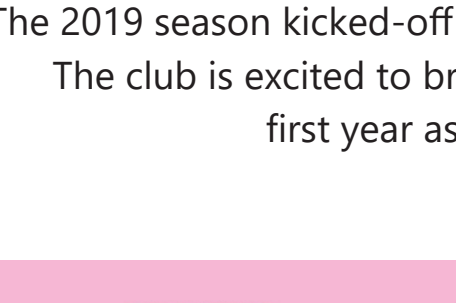

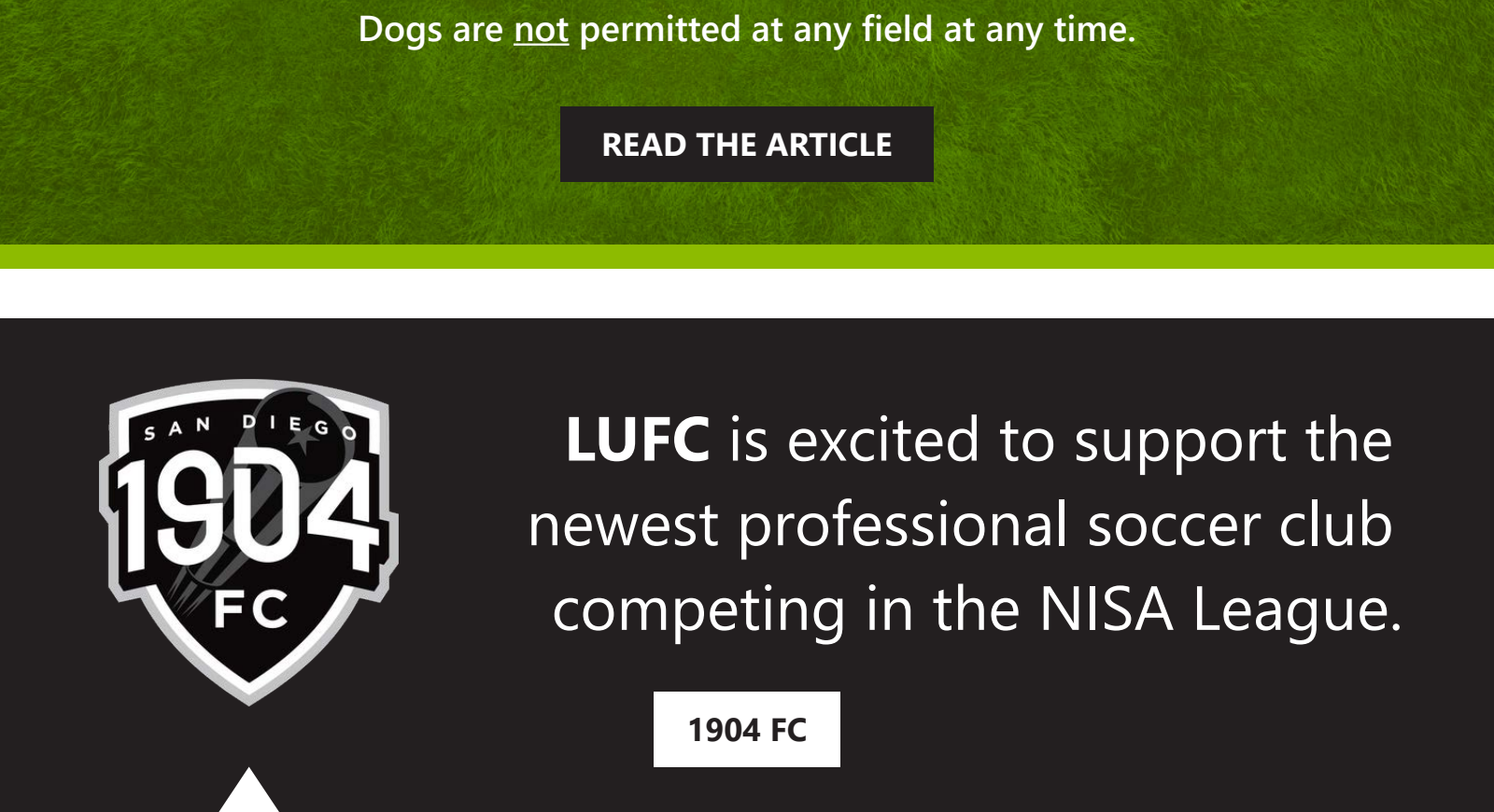

In July 2019, five of our current B2002 Blue team players were invited to attend the 1904 FC and San Diego Zest professional combine.

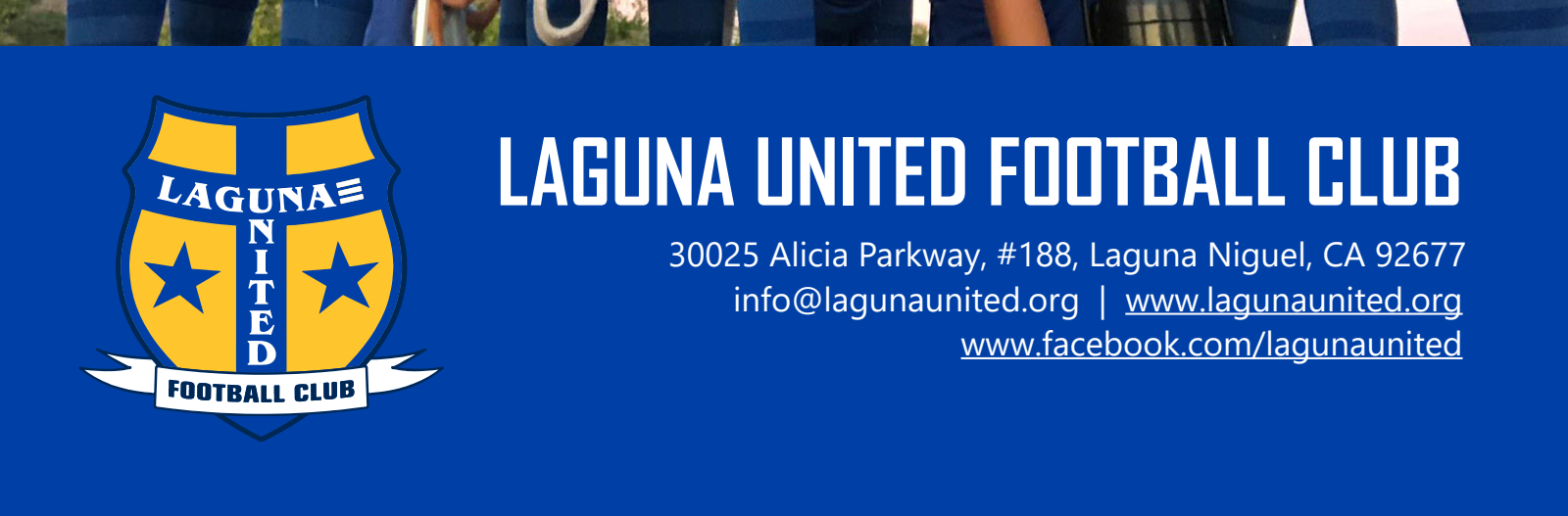


LUFC 2020-21 SEASON TRYOUTS
